Although a community foundation is always focused on the growth of its assets, the most important work we do is that of grantmaking. At the Rancho Santa Fe Foundation, we conduct our grantmaking activities, from discretionary funds, two times per year. That is to say, that those funds whose purpose is to support the community needs identified by local agencies and our Grants & Projects Committee, will provide grants semi-annually to assist with community development.
