It was the backdrop for a reception hosted by Lynn and Rich Cusac in their home on May 5<sup>th</sup> for former and current Foundation Directors. A number of those present were on the Board at the time of this wonderful donation of open space. Nancy Herrington was a Founding Director, Ann Rible's husband Mort was a Founding Director and Peg Bobertz's husband Chuck was a member of the Board at the time of the donation of the Ewing Preserve.

Chairman Dan Pittard welcomed guests, telling them that although the Foundation has grown 20 times in the past 28 years, we remain focused on donor centered, efficient and effective philanthropy.
